Toilets

Although Bleak House has toilets on the ground floor, we do not have a specific disabled toilet.

General Access

Access to our tea rooms is via two steps. Please be aware that there is no wheelchair ramp.

If entering via Church Road - this road is level. All other roads are on a moderate gradient.

There is no car park at Bleak House. Two public car parks are just 300 meters from the main entrance.

Menus

We provide large print menus.

Public Transport

Broadstairs is served by High Speed Javelin trains that take just 79 minutes from London's St. Pancras station

Southeast Trains also operate a half-hourly service from London, Victoria.

Taxis are readily available from the station - journey time about 4 minutes. Average walking time from the station to Bleak House is 15 minutes (800 meters).

Buses are operated by Stagecoach who provide a 'Thanet Loop' service. Nearest bus stop is 400 meters.
